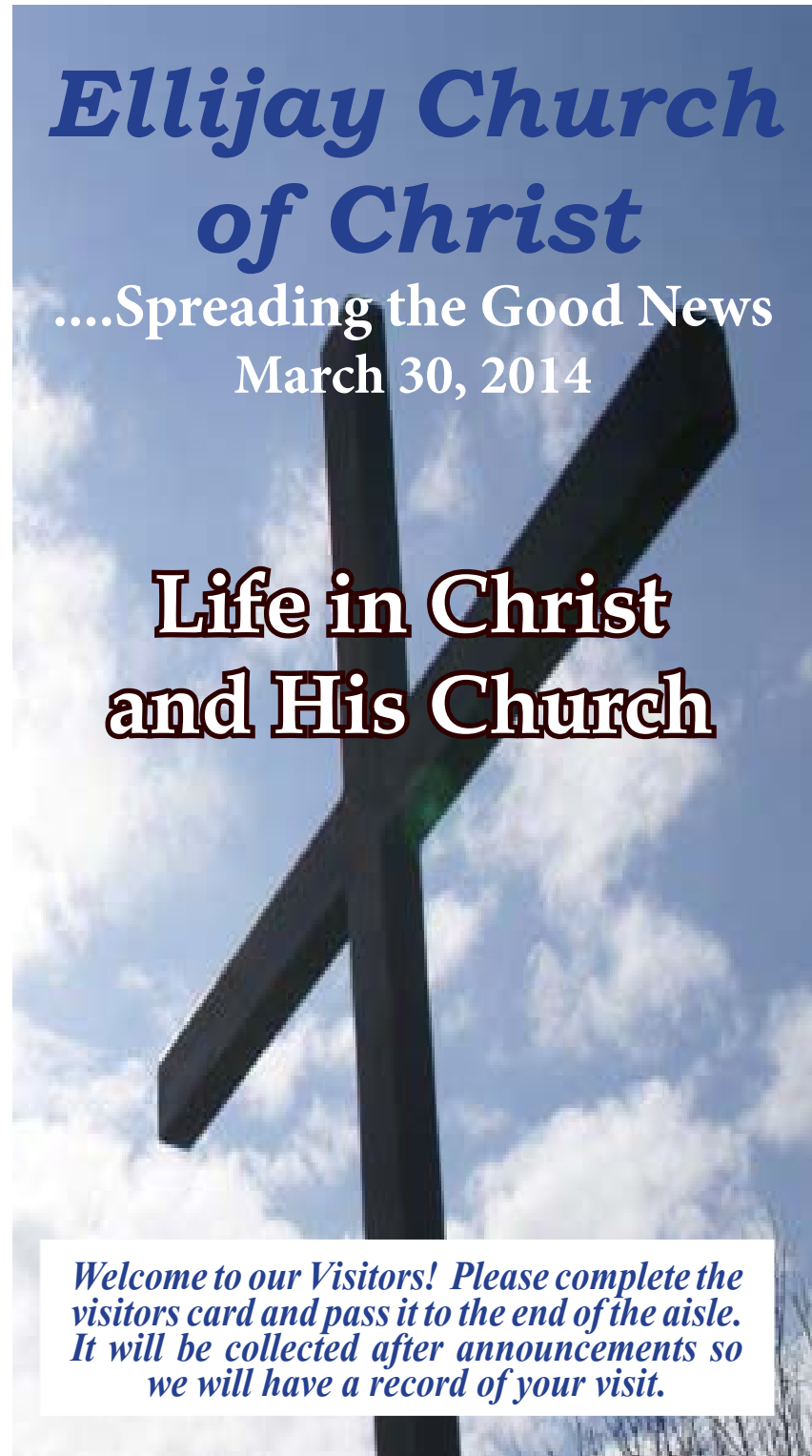

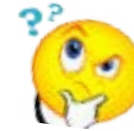
And Jesus' statement rings true, "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God" (Matthew 5:8).
