Billy Teague, David's father, was recently diagnosed with a very rare form of leukemia. If you would like to send a card or note:

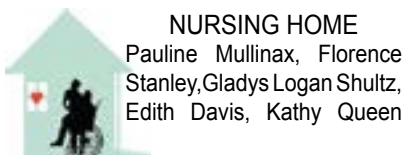
