Edmund Burke once said, "All that is necessary for the triumph of evil is that good men do nothing."

James teaches us that if we fail do what is good, then we have sinned. In James 4:17 "Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin."

This teaches us that we cannot just avoid the evil way, we must also actively do good works for the Lord. If we know something that needs to be done, we need to do it and not delay. If we put off doing something to long, we may find ourselves caught up in a sin because good intentions don't get anything done.

A good example of this comes from the plot that Joseph's brothers came up with to kill him. Ruben, who was the oldest brother, knew that it would be wrong for his brothers to kill Joseph, so he came up with a rescue plan. Instead of shedding his blood, he told them to just throw him in a deep pit and leave him there. Of course Ruben was going to sneak back and get him out the pit later, but slave traders came along and the brothers decided to sell Joseph into slavery without Ruben knowing. Ruben had good intentions, but his slow reaction led to Joseph being sold into slavery. Instead of telling the truth or trying to correct the wrong, he joined in the lie of his brothers that Joseph was dead. Was Ruben there when Joseph was sold into slavery? No, but he was just as guilty of sin because he joined in this lie.

Stand up for the truth. "And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell." Matthew 10:28 When good men do nothing, nothing good gets done.
