### Chase's Challenge NOTE TO PARENTS

Last week I began an idea which was intended to strengthen the faith of the young people here at the Ellijay congregation. I called it, Chase's Challenge. I have decided to continue this endeavor. Each week I will post a question on the youth page in the bulletin to answer. These questions will be discussion questions that allow our parents and youth to talk together about our faith and about Christianity. It is my hope that this will strengthen the spiritual bonds of the families here at the Ellijay congregation. I ask for your assistance in this endeavor by discussing these questions with your children and children discussing with parents. This week's question is:

How did we choose the Church of Christ?

In today's world, there are more varieties of churches than there are flavors at a Baskin Robins ice cream shop. Like the different flavors, these churches look and taste different from each other, some radically so. Why do we attend the Church of Christ? Why do we call ourselves this? All of these things go into the decision of where we will attend church. But most importantly, which church is the Church. Which church is the Church of Scripture? Note: These are discussion questions. They are meant to create deep thought and consideration in order to strengthen us spiritually. As such, answers such as the Bible says so, Jesus says so, or God says so are not enough. Prove that God and Jesus said so through scripture. Use passages of the Bible to strengthen your discussion. Grow closer together and more importantly, grow closer to God together.
