Green Clippings

I am often accused of using hyperbole in my descriptions of people or events. It seems that I have on many occasions seen "the funniest thing ever" or watched the "best television show in history" or even called an athlete the "greatest of all time" a bit prematurely. This behavior also frequently manifests itself in my teaching and preaching about God's Word. I have about fifty "favorite" passages of scripture and have called probably a dozen passages the "most important, powerful, etc." while trying to emphasize their significance.

Today, though, I want to share a verse that I really believe is the most frustrating in all of scripture as it pertains to practical application. Romans 12:18 says **"If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men."** Paul's exhortation here would be much more palatable if he deleted that pesky middle phrase "as much as depends on you!"

In a dispute, we often justify our anger in our minds by saying that the other person is the guilty party. If I can remove the blame from myself, it becomes easier to rationalize. Here, though, Paul's implication is that the other person's attitude does not matter – WE are responsible for peace! Certainly, there are times when we can do nothing to change someone's attitude toward us, but as Christians we cannot harbor anger and break the peace that God so desires! This is a weighty challenge given to us in a section of the book of Romans that is often subtitled "behave like Christians" by translators in our Bibles.

The next time that we do not want to apologize and begin to hold a grudge, I pray that we remember Paul's instruction to make peace when we have the opportunity!



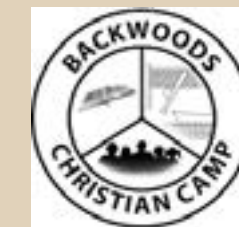
