I appreciate so much the prayers and support for my family during my surgery and rehab. I have looked forward to today for several weeks now following my recovery.

The lesson today is on “The Parable of the Mustard Seed” from Matthew 13:31-32. Jesus used the smallest of seeds to make the point about the growth of the Lord's Church. It began small with He and twelve followers. In Acts 1, we read about the 120 disciples and on Pentecost there were 3,000 added to the church. We read several more verses and there are 5,000 added, and from there, we read of where the number being added to the church multiplied.

Today, many people would like to know the secret to the growth of the Lord's Church. I believe the answer is found in Acts 8:4, “they went everywhere preaching the Word.” I saw an interesting comment recently, and it started me thinking about Acts 8. The preachers (apostles) stayed in Jerusalem, and the people went out everywhere! The key to church growth today is not in buildings or programs. The key is to follow the Bible's plan. We must carry the Gospel with us everywhere we go- to the ball park, to work, to the restaurants, on vacation. Any place we go and every place we go, we carry the Gospel to those we can influence and tell about Jesus.

Church growth might start small, but just think of the mustard seed and how big it can become!

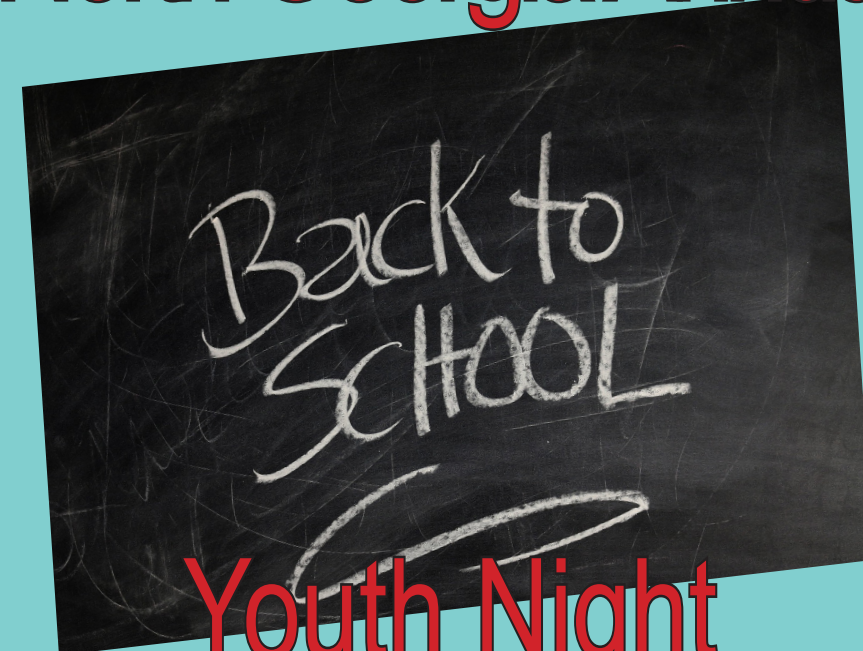
