Rob Burton is under dr's care for shingles in his eye.

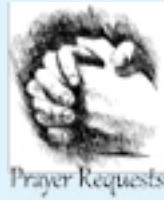
Rick Jones is under dr's care for kidney stones.

Chase's Challenge
