GREEN CLIPPINGS

"Pray Without Ceasing"

1 Thessalonians 5:17 is a frequently quoted verse that explains how prayer should be a part of our everyday lives. Much of our time together as a church family is spent in prayer. In fact, we always begin and end each assembly with an "opening" and "closing" prayer. We pray before we partake of the Lord's Supper, and we pray together for those who choose to respond to the invitation at the end of the lesson. Thankfully, our elders also have set aside a special period this afternoon for us to meet and pray together as a congregation for many of our specific needs as well as to show gratitude to God for the tremendous blessings he has showered down upon us. Still, it seems that prayer often ceases when we leave the four walls of our church building.

I understand that each of us compartmentalize our lives in some way – we have family, neighbors, work associates, and Christian friends that each play a different role on our spectrum of friends and acquaintances. This CANNOT be the case with God! If we are only talking with Him as we are publicly led by others, how can we claim that we love Him and He is the number one priority in our lives?! Through the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ, we have been given a direct line of communication with the creator of the world in which the Spirit himself intercedes for us when we don't know what to say or how to say it (Romans 8:26)! This is the most amazing privilege that the world has ever known!

I want to challenge each of us to have a more active prayer life both individually and with our families. We should all be talking to God throughout the day, and not just in pressure-filled circumstances – there should be a constant communication! We also need to be praying with our spouses for guidance and about family decisions, and we certainly need to teach our children to talk to God. I know life is busy, but we should never be too busy to share the contents of our heart with our Heavenly Father. He loves us, and he is waiting to hear from us! Pray without ceasing.
