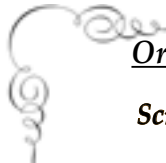

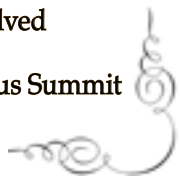

**Daddy's Hands**

I have a book in my personal library entitled Know Your Bible and written by Frank J. Dunn. Contained within the volume is a synopsis of every book of the Bible as well as a list of the major themes and key verses. Brother Dunn was a renowned preacher for several decades in both San Antonio and Dallas, Texas, and this particular book is arguably the most popular among preaching students.

Bro. Dunn was perhaps just as successful in raising his family. He was married to a wonderful woman who was a homemaker and sought after artist, and he had four children who went on to prosper in their own lives. One of his three sons is a dentist in Texas, and one is a top realtor in the state. His third son is a now-retired songwriter in Nashville who wrote several chart toppers including "She Never Lets it Go to Her Heart" recorded by Tim McGraw and "You're Easy on the Eyes" recorded by Terri Clark. It is his fourth child, and only daughter, that is the most well-known of his offspring. It was Holly Dunn who released a Grammy-nominated song in 1986 called "Daddy's Hands" which was written about the love and instruction she received from her Christian father.

In the introduction of his book Bro. Dunn writes, "Know Your Bible to find the Christian way of life, worship, and service. The inspired scriptures are the only doctrine of the New Testament church. The scriptures alone furnish us completely unto all good works (II Tim. 3:16-17). The inspired Word teaches us that denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in this present world (Titus 2:12)." It is no coincidence that Bro. Dunn's children succeeded personally and professionally; he raised them according to the precepts he found in the inspired Word of God! We should all seek to follow his example and learn to know our Bibles!
