## SUGGESTIONS ON HOW TO WORSHIP

Thank you for you comments on the lesson last week on "Worship." I came across this article this week and thought it might be helpful.

1. Prepare everything Saturday so that Sunday will be as free as possible from household tasks, etc. Go to bed early Saturday night and get a good rest.
2. Avoid the Sunday morning rush. This will allow time to look over the Bible class lesson, and will also keep down tempers that too much hurrying often aggravates.
3. On the way to church, prepare your mind for worship. Water the flowers of reverence in your heart with some worth while thoughts.
4. Upon entering the building, be quiet and reverent. When you take your seat, glance through the words of a song for thoughts that you have missed, or read your lesson for the morning again.
5. When the song service begins, enter in with a whole heart. If you are a poor singer, try all the harder to blend your voice with the others.
6. When the sermon is preached, apply the thoughts to your own life. As you hear God's will, determine to obey it.
7. Do not let the communion become common place to you. Each time you partake, try to gain some new lesson from the suffering of our Savior.
