"WHAT IS THE CHURCH OF CHRIST?"

1. It is a church that has a biblical name - (Romans 16:16). The church of Christ does not wear a human name, but rather it wears the name of Christ. The church belongs to Jesus, therefore it is only proper that we wear His name.
2. It is a church built by Jesus - (Matthew 16:18). The church was not established by man, it was established by Jesus.
3. It is a church that has Jesus as its head - (Col. 1:18). The church does not have an earthly headquarters or many earthly heads, it has only one head and that head is Jesus.
4. It is a church that speaks the oracles of God - (1 Peter 4:11). The church does not teach or preach man's opinion, but rather it proclaims the doctrine of Christ.
5. It is a church that observes New Testament worship and worships in spirit and in truth - (John 4:24). In the church of Christ you will find the following items of worship:
 - a. Lord's Supper - Matt. 26:26-29; 1 Cor. 11:20-40; Acts 20:7
 - b. Singing - Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16
 - c. Praying - Acts 2:42; 1 Thess. 5:17
 - d. Giving - 1 Cor. 16:1-2
 - e. Teaching - Acts 2:42; 1 Tim. 3:15
 - f. Preaching - 2 Tim. 4:2
6. It is a church that practices New Testament baptism. Baptism in the New Testament is for the remission of sins - Acts 2:42. Baptism puts one into Christ - Gal. 3:26-27. A person can be saved by baptism - Mark 16:16. Baptism is a burial - Romans 6:3-4. One can inherit eternal life through baptism - John 3:5.

 - b. Believe - John 3:16
 - c. Repent - Luke 13:3
 - d. Confess - Acts 8:37
 - e. Be baptized - Mark 16:16
