Breann Pritchett is showing improvement. Thank you for your prayers and continue to keep the prayers going.

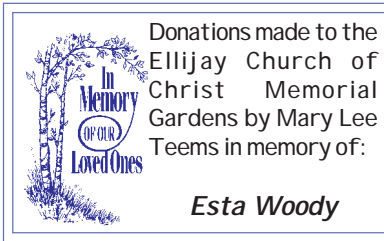
We express our sympathy to the family of Wilma Sisson in her passing away. Wilma is Alan Sisson's mother and Sandra Pankey's aunt.
