We concluded a great Gospel Meeting last week entitled, "In God We Trust." The Bible major students from Faulkner did excellent in preparing for the lessons. I hope you will encourage all of the young men in our church family to consider preaching the Gospel as they prepare for their future.

On Tuesday, September 21st, Walter Breuning, of Great Falls, Montana, celebrated another birthday. If you've never heard of Mr. Breuning, you are not alone, many people haven't. Then what is so special, you ask? Walter Breuning appears in the 2011 edition of the Guinness Book of World Records as the Oldest Man. He just celebrated his 114th birthday! In a speech he delivered on his birthday last Tuesday, the world's oldest man urged people to rely on their faith. "With all the hatred in this good world, let us be kind to one another," he is quoted as saying.

I don't know about you, but this reminds me of two different scriptures in the Bible. All of us have probably been taught "the Golden Rule," since we were young. "So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them..." Matthew 7:12. We all may know the Golden Rule, but do we always live by it?

If anyone can tell us how things are different, it would be someone celebrating their 114th birthday. Mr. Breuning should be able to tell us about how times have changed. After all, he has seen 20 U.S. Presidents come and go, lived in three centuries and survived two World Wars - although in WWI he was not called up and in WWII he was considered too old to fight. And yet, he is quoted as saying, "Every year is the same." This simple quote brings to mind wise King Solomon, who is quoted saying in Ecclesiastes 1:9, "What has been is what will be, and what has been done is what will be done, and there is nothing new under the sun."

When we find ourselves worried or stressed, remember- there is nothing that God can't handle, nothing that He hasn't helped someone with before, and nothing He can't help you with, too. And remember, the world can always use some more of the Golden Rule.
