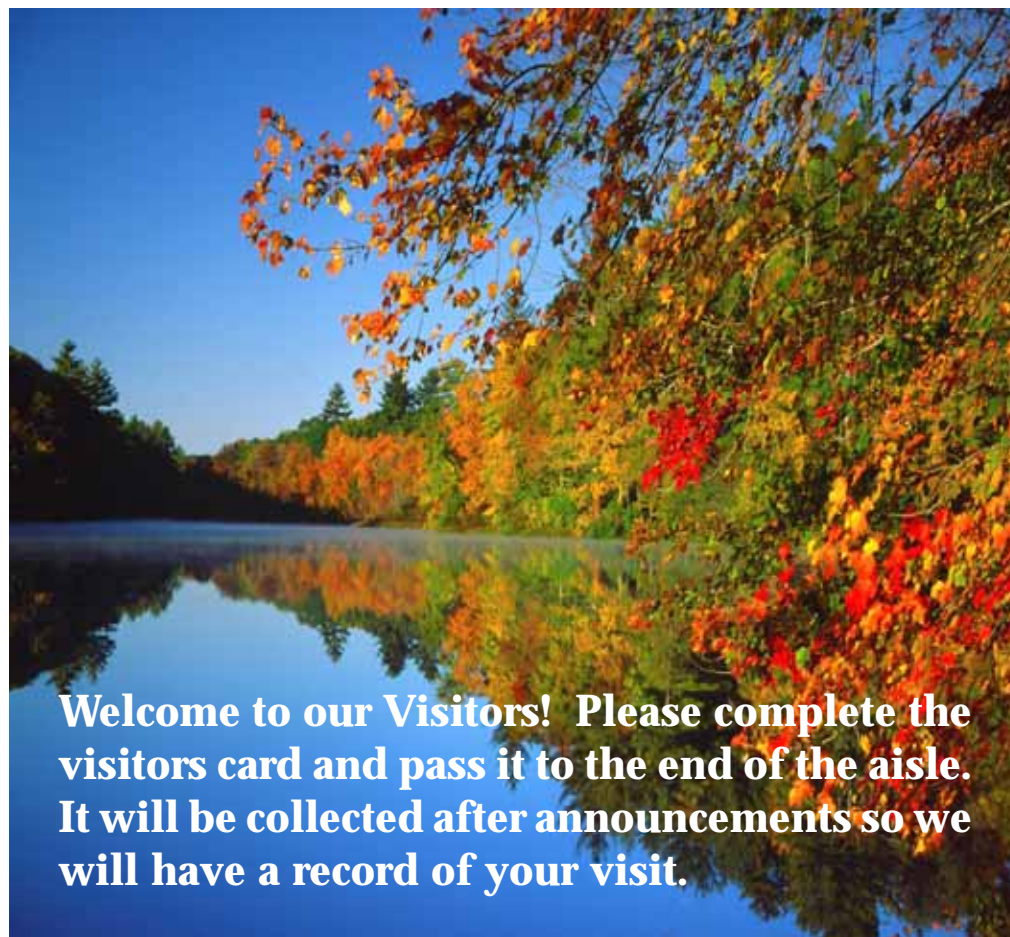

There is something unique and special about Thanksgiving Day. It isn't so totally commercial as most other holidays, including Christmas. It still focuses on getting together with the people we love most, sharing food, and talking.

Travel? You bet! Whether you plan to drive or fly, the Wednesday before Thanksgiving will be the busiest travel day of the year. Even with the high cost of gasoline on highways and in spite of the aggravation of passenger screening at airports, people want to be with parents, siblings, cousins, and best friends.

Assuming that you or your family members are likely to be on the road or in the air, you are going to be included in my prayers for safety and protection. I would like to have your prayers as we travel to see children and grandchildren.

Food. Ah, yes! The turkeys have been flying out of Kroger of late – but not one, of course, under its own power. They will be cooked, basted, adorned, side-dished, devoured, sandwiched, and turkey-salad (?) over the following few days. Everybody will claim to be "sick of the stuff" by the weekend.

Truth be told, however, even the griping about eating turkey in so many creative combinations is part of the tradition. Gathering around a table, praising the cooks, smiling at one another, and joining hands to pray – it is the beginning of the warm and bonding events that affirm everyone called to the circle.

And the talking. Above all else, there is conversation that ranges from reminiscing about persons now missing to excitement over fiancées, newborns, and pregnancies being announced. Family narratives are told yet again for the sake of burning them into the memory of the youngest and newest to the table.
