In our Wednesday night Bible study, we have been studying through the Book of Hebrews. At the end of chapter 6, the writer assures us that we can trust God's promises. Just as God kept his covenant with Abraham, we can be assured that God will deliver on our promise of eternal life.

In verses 19 and 20 we are told that Jesus now serves as our High Priest and King just like Melchizedek. Jesus is the forerunner for us in that through him we have unlimited access to God in contrast to having access through an earthly priest.

Perhaps the most memorable statement in the passage comes from verse 19 when we're told that God's promises serve as the anchor of our soul. No matter what storms we face in life, we can remain unmoved because our High Priest and King has paid the sacrifice for our eternal life!

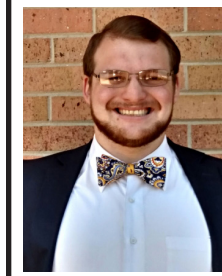
