

Roy Campanella was one of the first African Americans to play in the US Baseball major leagues. In a distinguished career he won the Brooklyn Dodgers Most Valued Player award many times, and in 1955 was in the team that won the World Series.

But in January 1958 his career was cut short after a car crash left him a quadriplegic. After he was injured he spent a lot of time in the Institute of Physical medicine and Rehabilitation in New York City. One day he stopped to read a gold plague upon one of the walls, and for someone who had been blessed with such athletic gifts it resonated deeply within him:

"I asked God for strength, that I might achieve.

I was made weak, that I might learn to humbly obey...

I asked for health that I might do great things.

I was given infirmity that might do better things...

I asked for riches that I might be happy,

I was given poverty that I might be wise...

I asked for power, that I might have the praise of others.

I was given weakness that I might feel the need of God...

I asked for all things, that I might enjoy life.


I was given life that I might enjoy all things...
