

**Cost:** Sites are \$40 / night with full hook up. Premiere sites (lake view) are \$50 / night

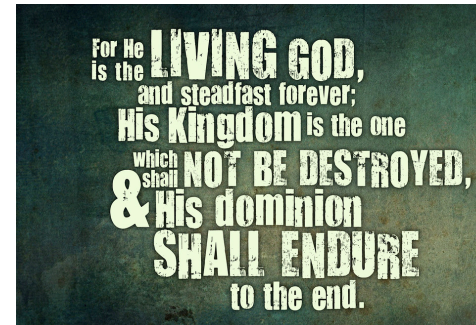
**Check In:** 1:00 PM
