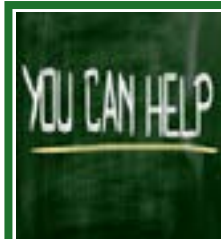

Last week's challenge, we discussed the role of the Christian family. I hope that everyone learned something from the discussion last week. This week's challenge is along the same lines. As Christians we are given certain responsibilities from Jesus and from God that we are expected to fulfill. Jesus himself said, "Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him." (John 14:21, ESV). Jesus expected us to do certain things, not because by our actions we are justified, but because our faith in him should produce good works. This week's challenge is...

What are our responsibilities as Christians?

What has Jesus told us that we need to do as Christians? What does he expect of us? Is it simply showing up to services every Sunday and Wednesday? What are we supposed to be doing as Christians? What are these good works that Jesus talks about? What fruit should we be producing as Christians? This is an exercise to grow closer together while growing in knowledge and understanding of God's word. Note: These are discussion questions. They are meant to create deep thought and consideration in order to strengthen us spiritually. As such, answers such as the Bible says so, Jesus says so, or God says so are not enough. Prove that God and Jesus said so through scripture. Use passages of the Bible to strengthen your discussion. Grow closer together and more importantly, grow closer to God together.
