The Elders have challenged each of us, adults and youth, to participate in the Parade of Winners. The following is the requirements from the Lads to Leaders Handbook.

PARADE OF WINNERS (Reading the Bible)

This is a non-competitive event...one competes only with self.

PURPOSE

To encourage students and adults to read the Scriptures. There is no Convention participation for this award. This is a local, year-round event where participants read their Bibles.

EVENT RULES AND GUIDELINES

- To qualify, the student or adult must read either the entire New Testament (one medal) or entire Old Testament (one medal) prior to the convention registration deadline. If a person reads the entire Bible – Old and New Testaments – he/she will receive two medals.
- The reading may be from any standard translation not a paraphrase. Seek advice from your church leadership regarding various standard translations.
- Individuals may listen to audio tapes or CDs to qualify.
- All reading must be done within a 12 month period or less and must be done prior to convention registration deadline. Do not register for this event if the work is not completed by the registration deadline. **Group leaders are to electronically verify each participant of this event in the registration system.**
- A student or adult can qualify for more than one award in a calendar year by completely re-reading the (Old or New) Testament or reading the entire Bible prior to Convention registration deadline.
