We welcome everyone to our worship service this morning. If you are visiting with us, we hope you come back often. This morning's service is centered around our youth, and we appreciate the talents they have and use for the Lord.

A youth is a person who is going to carry on what you have started. He will assume control of your cities, states, and nations. He is going to take over your churches, schools, and corporations. You may adopt all the policies you please, but how they are carried out depends on him. So it might be well to pay him some attention. Studies have shown, 75% of all people who become Christians, do so by age 25.

A community club was discussing the proposed establishment of a youth center. A youthful member of the club spoke out in favor of having a young person oversee the center; someone young enough, she said, to know what teenagers really like to do. Yes, agreed an older member, but also old enough to see that they don't.

Consider the following quotes:

- Young people need control and authority; and without it they are unhappy, confused, frustrated, and miserable. This is one of the psychological secrets that Hitler and Mussolini used so effectively in gaining control of the youth of Germany and Italy.

- Adolescence is the awkward age in the life of a youngster. They're too old for an allowance and too young for a credit card.
- A boy becomes an adult three years before his parents think he does and about two years after he thinks he does. - Lewis Hershey
