The work in Jamaica has had an impact not only in those in Jamaica who have been taught, but also on the Americans who have put forth the effort to go and assist in carrying out the Great Commission. Hundreds of Bible studies have been conducted that have resulted in many new brothers and sisters in Christ. Brothers and sisters in Jamaica have been edified and the lives of many of our brethren have been changed as a result of working in a country that many would consider third world.

Linda Benskin, former missionary in Yendi, Ghana

"Some visitors ... have made a tremendous positive impact on the local church by being humble and having a servant spirit. Dr. Frank Black came to Yendi and helped see patients at the clinic, working side-by-side with the locals. When the patients had all been seen, he picked up a paintbrush and helped paint the clinic walls. That was so huge to the local people. His visit had a very positive impact."

Dave Culbreath, who lead a group of 28 to Morant Bay, Jamaica, for a Spring Break mission trip

"It's an excellent opportunity across the board. Our team members become exposed to life-changing opportunities, by way of missions, and the church in Jamaica is strengthened by the encouragement we do our best to provide them."

"Yes, they are helpful, and we need (such teams). People here need to know that they have brothers and sisters in Christ all over the world."
