Thank you for joining us on Father's Day, 2010. A special welcome to Richard and Mary Harp. Richard will be teaching a combined Bible class in the auditorium as well as bringing the morning lesson. He and Mary will be leaving this week for Scotland for 5 years of mission work. Please keep them in your prayers in their service to the Lord.

Happy Father's Day to all of our Fathers and Grandfathers. Father's Day began in the United States, but no one knows quite where and when. Some say that Mrs. John Dowd of West Virginia began Father's Day to honor her own father, who raised his family after his wife died.

Others say it was launched in Spokane, Washington, in June, 1910, by Mrs. John Bruce Dodd. Mrs. Dodd wanted a special day to honor her father, William Smart. William Smart, a Civil War veteran, was widowed when his wife died in childbirth with their sixth child. Mr. Smart was left to raise the newborn and his other five children by himself. It was after Mrs. Dodd became an adult that she realized the strength and selflessness her father had shown in raising his children as a single parent.

Father's Day has become a day not only to honor fathers, but all men who act as a father figure. Stepfathers, uncles, grandfathers, and adult male friends all play a part in fathering, and deserve to be honored on Father's Day.

Our Heavenly Father deserves our honor and love as well, not just today but everyday. Jesus tells us in John 14: 22-24, "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me."
