Independence Day, or better known as the 4th of July, is a wonderful holiday. It brings to mind cookouts and fireworks, and is a favorite holiday for adults and children alike. The true meaning behind the 4th of July Independence Day, however, came about as the result of strong values and commitments of our forefathers before us.

Brave people left everything behind to cross the Atlantic Ocean and come to a new land to have rights and freedoms not available to them in their homeland. Towns and colonies were built and managed under new laws, but they were still under the authority of England.

The decision for the new land to become independent of England actually occurred on July 2, 1776 by the Continental Congress in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Congress formally approved the document, known as the "Declaration of Independence", on July 4, 1776. This was the final break with Great Britain. The colonies were united in their desire to be independent. They stood together and were not deterred as they sought to bring about rights and freedoms they had so wanted.

How committed and dedicated are we today in doing the Lord's work? If independence from the devil depends solely on us, will it be a victory? As Paul tells us in I Timothy 3, "But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty," he also tells us in chapter 4 to "preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching. For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching."

We have an obligation and duty to spread the Word to everyone that will listen. Jesus tells us to "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." As America celebrates her freedom, I hope you will remember to keep the Campaigners in your prayers as we help to spread the Gospel in Jamaica.
