We have started new Bible classes Sunday mornings on "Teaching Others One on One." The ladies are meeting in the fellowship hall and the men meet in the classroom off of it. The auditorium class is studying the book of Hebrews. We hope everyone will make a special effort to join us for these new classes as well as all of our services here at the Ellijay congregation. In view of this, we hope you enjoy the following poem, "Here Am I, Send Me," written by Cleah Boaz.

Lord, I am ready to do your will, to help spread the gospel in any way that I can. Just tell me what You want me to do. But remember Lord, I am not comfortable around sick people in the hospital, and nursing homes are so depressing. But just tell me what You want me to do. However, I just can't walk up to someone I have never met and introduce myself to them, even at worship services—I am just too shy. I can't go to funeral homes, I never know what to say to someone who has just lost a loved one. I might say the wrong thing. But I am sure there are many other things that I can do. But remember, Lord, I work very hard during the week and need to rest on Saturdays so I won't be able to work at the building—it is all I can do to get my own house in order. And I have so many allergies that I won't be able to do any of the yard work—I even have to wear a protective mask when I mow my own grass. And I never get to church early enough to unlock the building and I need to leave as soon as services are over so I won't be able to unlock and lock the building, but I am ready to work, just tell me what You would have me do. By the way, Lord, I am not a very good cook, and no one would like anything I might prepare so taking food to someone might not be a good thing for me to do. That is why I don't ever attend fellowship meals. I am not a very good driver so it probably would not be a good idea for me to take people to the doctor because I might get lost or have an accident. And I just don't have the talent to teach a class. But if there is anything I can do Lord, just send me. But please remember Lord that I lead a very busy life—why I am so busy that sometimes I can't remember where I put my Bible last Sunday when I got back from worship. But I am ready to work, Lord, just send me.
