### SOMETHING BEAUTIFUL

Women in nearly record numbers, we're told, were drawn in envy to the picture of a well-known movie actress on the cover of a popular magazine. She had been portrayed as possessing flawless beauty....

But the editors of another magazine published a follow-up story telling about a photo company that had billed the first magazine \$1,525 for their work on the picture "to clean up complexion, soften eye line, soften smile line, add color to lips, trim chin, ...adjust color, and add hair on the top of the head."
