**November 6, 2016**

I told you last week that Game 7 of the World Series would be a night that lived on in baseball lore. Little did I realize that it would go down as one of the greatest baseball games ever played that ended with the Chicago Cubs winning their first championship since 1908! I must admit it was also one of the best nights of my life as a die-hard Cubs fan! Game 7 had everything – pitching, offense, defense, extra innings, even a rain delay! The biggest moment, however, came when Ben Zobrist, the World Series MVP, lined a double down the left field line to break a 6-6 tie in the top of the 10th inning. Zobrist, who had already won a World Series title in Kansas City, will remember that moment for the rest of his life.

Still, it pales in comparison to a moment that many of us have already had and that, through his grace, God has made available to the whole world! 5. We are Adopted as Sons – Ephesians 1:5
6. We are Guaranteed an Eternal Inheritance – Ephesians 1:11-14
7. We Become Citizens of the Heavenly Kingdom – Philippians 3:20-21
8. We Become Disciples of the King of Kings and Lord of Lords – 1 Timothy 6:15
9. Reservations are Made for our Permanent Home – John 14:1-3
10. We Begin a New Life of Faithfulness – Revelation 2:10




