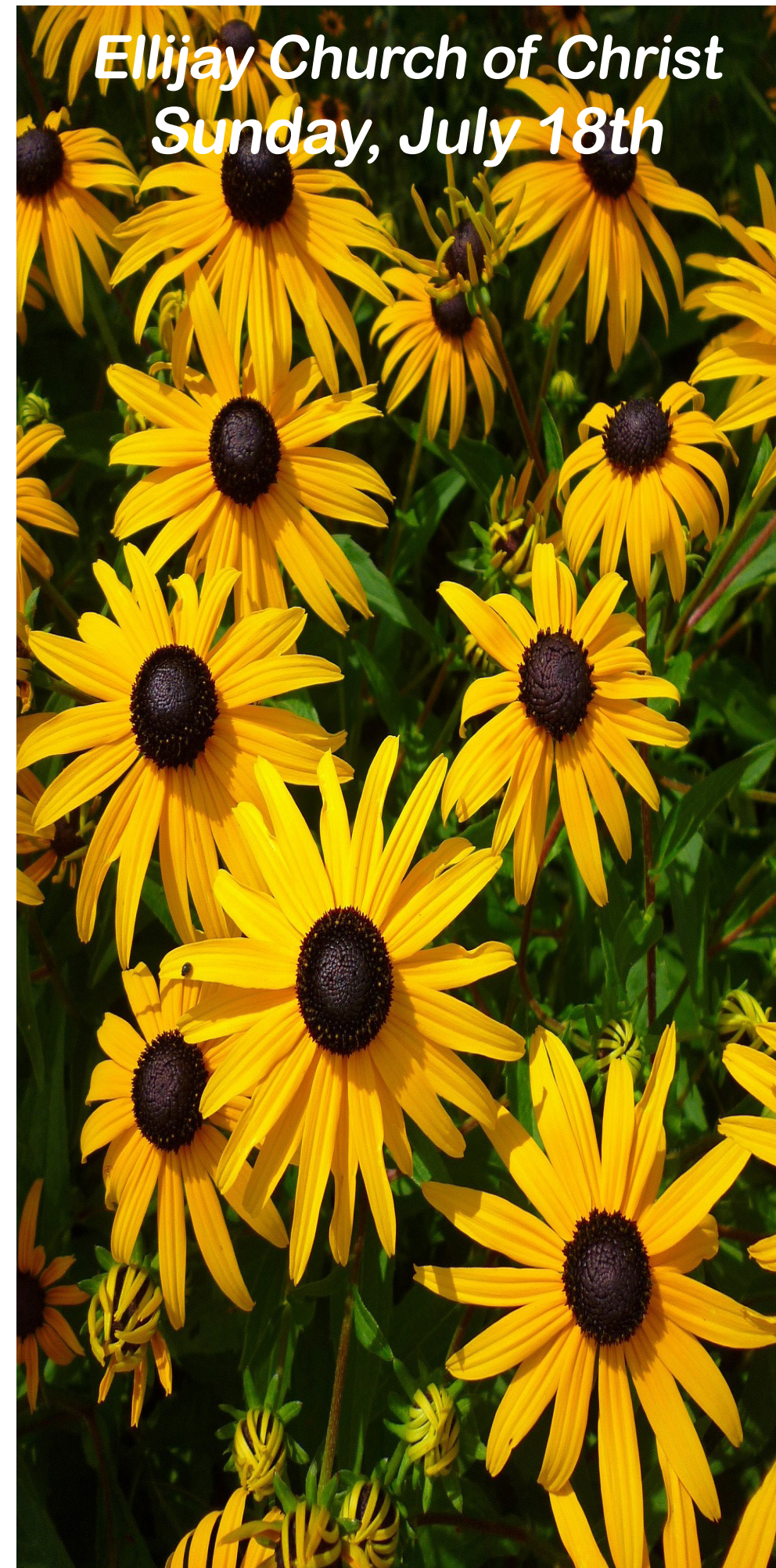

Daily Devotionals
 July 18-24

Sunday – As we contemplate the value that God has placed on our lives (Psalm 8; Gen. 1:26-27; John 3:16; John 14:1-4), how does that change the way that we view others? Think back to our Sunday morning lesson from July 11 for some potential areas of growth.

Monday – The word in the Bible for being “conformed” is used in Romans 12:2 and 1 Peter 1:14. What pressures do we have as young people and adults to conform to the world around us?

Tuesday – In Proverbs 1:8-10, Solomon gives instructions for children to listen to their parents. What are some ways that we can work TOGETHER as families to avoid conforming? Look back at your notes from the Sunday morning lesson from July 18!

Wednesday – As adults, what are some of the pressures we feel from our peer group? How are these different from what young people face? How are they similar?

Thursday – Discuss some Bible characters that either resisted or succumbed to the pressure of those around them. What can we learn from these examples?

Friday – Search for some scriptures that talk about pleasing God rather than man. Read these in context and discuss some ways that we can avoid being “people pleasers.”

Saturday – In our everyday lives, and especially now through social media, we have a tremendous chance to be “influencers” to those around us. How are we succeeding in using our influence, and what are some ways that we could improve? Be honest and vulnerable!
