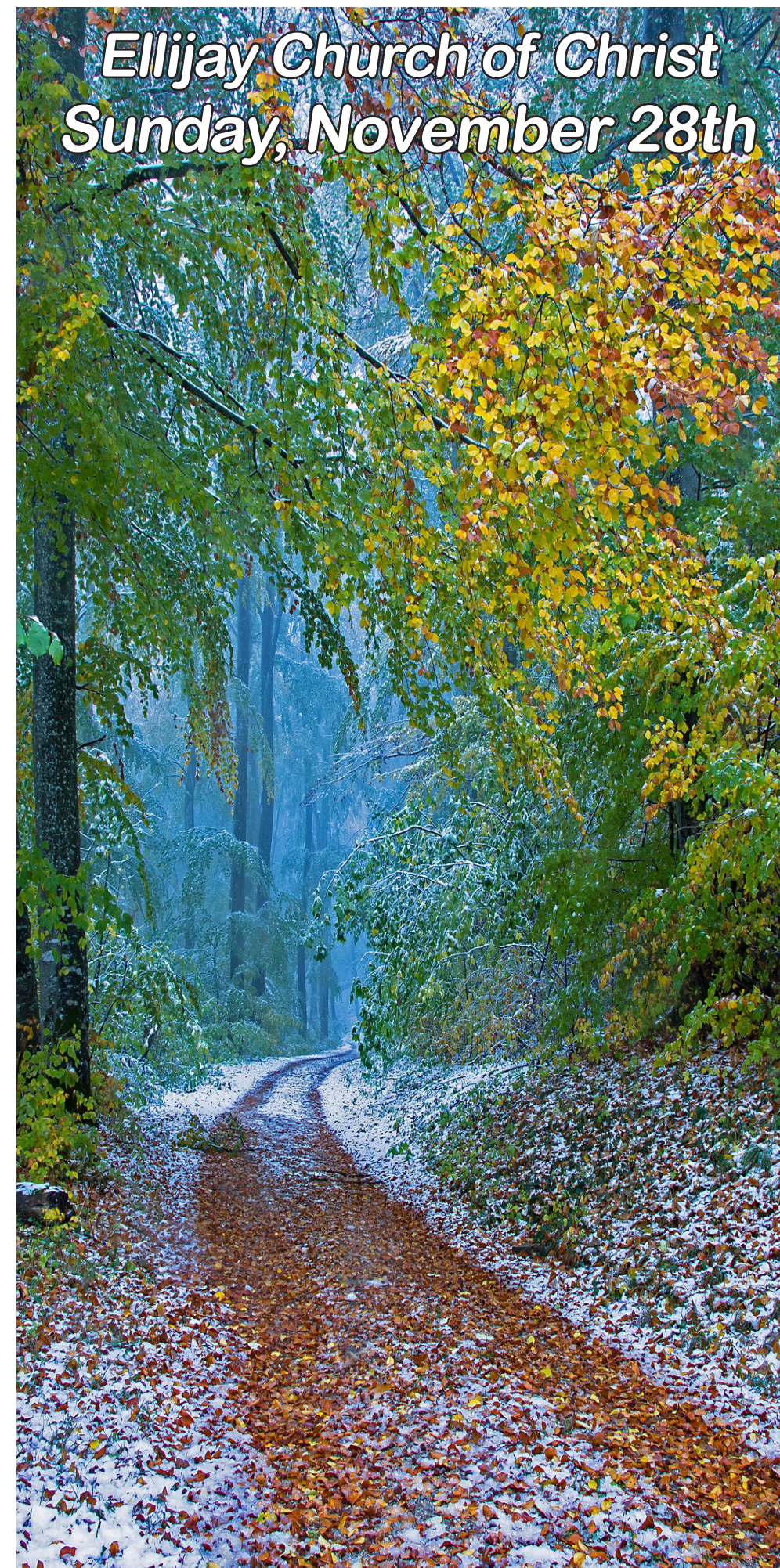

Thank you for being here this morning as we recover from our turkey-induced weekend slumber! I hope that everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving with family and friends and celebrated the holiday by thanking God for showering us with blessings!

This morning, we will conclude our study of the Holy Spirit during Bible class before starting a study of the Book of Galatians next Sunday. As we prepare for the winter quarter, I pray that we all realize the value of being involved in a Bible class, especially for our kids. As parents, when we bring our kids to class we are helping to build the foundation for their knowledge of God's Word!

During our 10:30 service, we are going to conclude our series of lessons about good works by looking at the ultimate example of Christian service. Acts 10:38 tells us that Jesus "went about doing good." We will look at how Jesus served and strive to follow his lead in our own lives!

Tonight, we will answer some of your questions during our monthly Q&A. We have gotten some really insightful questions, and we are looking forward to addressing them over the next couple of months. As always, if you have a question, you can send it to me through text or email!

Weekly Devotionals November 28 - December 4

Sunday - After our service this morning, have a family discussion about Jesus being a servant and how we can follow his example and be a servant to those around us!

Monday - Throughout November, we have talked about being "connected to good works." In Ephesians 2:1-10, we highlighted several key words that explain how God has saved us from wrath through his mercy, grace, and love. Today, talk about God's wrath and love and how they are both necessary. Read and discuss Romans 11:22.

Tuesday - Ephesians 2:10 says we are God's workmanship, handiwork, or masterpiece according to which translation you are reading from. It also says God created us for good works. What does this mean for our purpose and place in the world?

Wednesday - In Titus 3:1-2, Paul tells Titus to be subject to rulers and authorities while being peaceable and gentle. We also know that the Bible urges us to stand up for the truth in all circumstances (1 Cor. 16:13, etc.). Today, think about how to be gentle and peaceful while still being a soldier for Christ!

Thursday - In our Wednesday night study, we recently talked about God being righteous. In Titus 3:5, Paul is explicitly clear and stating that we cannot be saved by our own righteousness. Discuss the distinction between God's righteousness and our righteousness.

Friday - Titus 3:7 says that we are "heirs according to the hope of eternal life." We are very aware of the significance of an earthly inheritance, particularly if there is a lot of money involved. The death of a loved one sometimes brings out the worst kinds of greed. For Christians, an earthly inheritance is insignificant because we have a heavenly inheritance! What does this mean for the way we value things?

Saturday - Today, think about the value of good works. Titus 3:8 says we should be "careful to maintain good works" because they are "good and profitable." As we prepare for worship tomorrow, make a list of some good works to get involved in and focus on the biblical principle of being a servant.
