



Damien is a student at the Georgia School of Theology in Warner Robins, and he will spend the week with us as part of GST's program. He is nearing the halfway point in his studies, and we know he will be well taken care of by our church family this week!

We have so many opportunities to use our new facilities, and we appreciate everyone helping with the logistics of moving things back and forth. Make sure you are up to date on the calendar of events as we continue through a busy couple of months together; we are a blessed

## Daily Devotionals March 13th - 19th

Sunday – Dorian Flynn was here today sharing the work in Africa and delivering a lesson. As a family, spend some time today talking about the lesson and the value of mission work worldwide.

Monday – This year, we have chosen 2 Peter 1:3-11 as a key passage to go along with our theme. In the chapter, Peter outlines the Christian virtues beginning with goodness, Before goodness, he lays down faith as a foundation to build upon. Today, read James's description of faith in James 2:14-26 and discuss how faith and growth are connected.

Tuesday - In Acts 26:24, Paul is accused of going mad because of his faith-inspired discourse. What "crazy" things do we do in our lives because of our faith? Today, talk about how we can be bolder in the proclamation of our faith and our Christian lifestyle.

Wednesday – 1 Peter 1:6-7 talks about the refining process that makes our faith genuine. Today, discuss what this passage means for us and think about some hard times that have helped strengthen our faith.

Thursday - In Matthew 18:1-5, Jesus tells his disciples to have childlike faith. Today, let's discuss some of the attributes of children and how we can apply those to our faith to become more pleasing to God. What did Jesus mean when he made this broad statement?

Friday – The Greek word for goodness in 2 Peter 1 is arete, and it serves as an important term across the spectrum of Greek literature. A better translation of the word is excellence or moral excellence in this context. Think about goodness or excellence and discuss why Peter would say we need to add it to our faith to become stronger Christians.

Saturday – Yesterday, we talked about arete as used in 2 Peter 1. The word also sometimes is used to discuss courage along with excellence. For Christians, courage is an important attribute as we grow in our faith. Today, think about what it means to be courageous as we prepare to meet tomorrow for worship!
