- Continue to utilize Homework Club as a method of reaching young people and their parents
- Continue to use Homework Club to lead outreach to Spanish-speaking families in Ellijay

- · As elders, emphasize the role of shepherding and devotion to prayer and ministry of the Word
- · Continue to increase communication and delegation to deacons
- Utilize a mentoring program to identify and develop future elders and deacons
- Further utilize the Lads to Leaders program to develop leadership among young people
