MEMORIAL DAY HONORING ALL WHO SERVED

For many, it marks the unofficial start of summer as pools and outdoor activities open up, even though summer won't officially start until the end of June. But before you rev up those grills and kick up your feet, here's a reminder of the holiday's solemn purpose.

Memorial Day is observed every year "to mourn and honor its deceased service men and women," according to the National Cemetery Administration.

On Memorial Day, the flag is lowered to half-staff from sunrise until noon and then raised to full-staff for the remainder of the day. This process symbolizes mourning in the morning and a commitment to continue the fight for freedom in the afternoon. The flag's colors—red for bravery, white for purity, and blue for perseverance—carry deep meaning on this day of reflection.

Christ also died for us, to set us free!

"Therefore there is now no condemnation at all for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death. " Romans 8:1-4


